



The above described Tract of ten Acres & one hundred & forty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate in Hamilton Township Franklin County being part of two larger Tracts viz. 10<sup>acs</sup> 59<sup>ps</sup> & all being part of 19<sup>acs</sup> 68<sup>perches</sup>, which was Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Eaton<sup>Jur</sup> dated the 28<sup>th</sup> Feby. 1775 & the small triangle included containing 88 perches is part of 185<sup>acs</sup> 40<sup>p</sup> & all which was Surveyed. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James Eaton bearing date 31<sup>st</sup> of March 1751. Resurveyed & divided off for Michael Shearer the 11<sup>th</sup> of March 1824.
