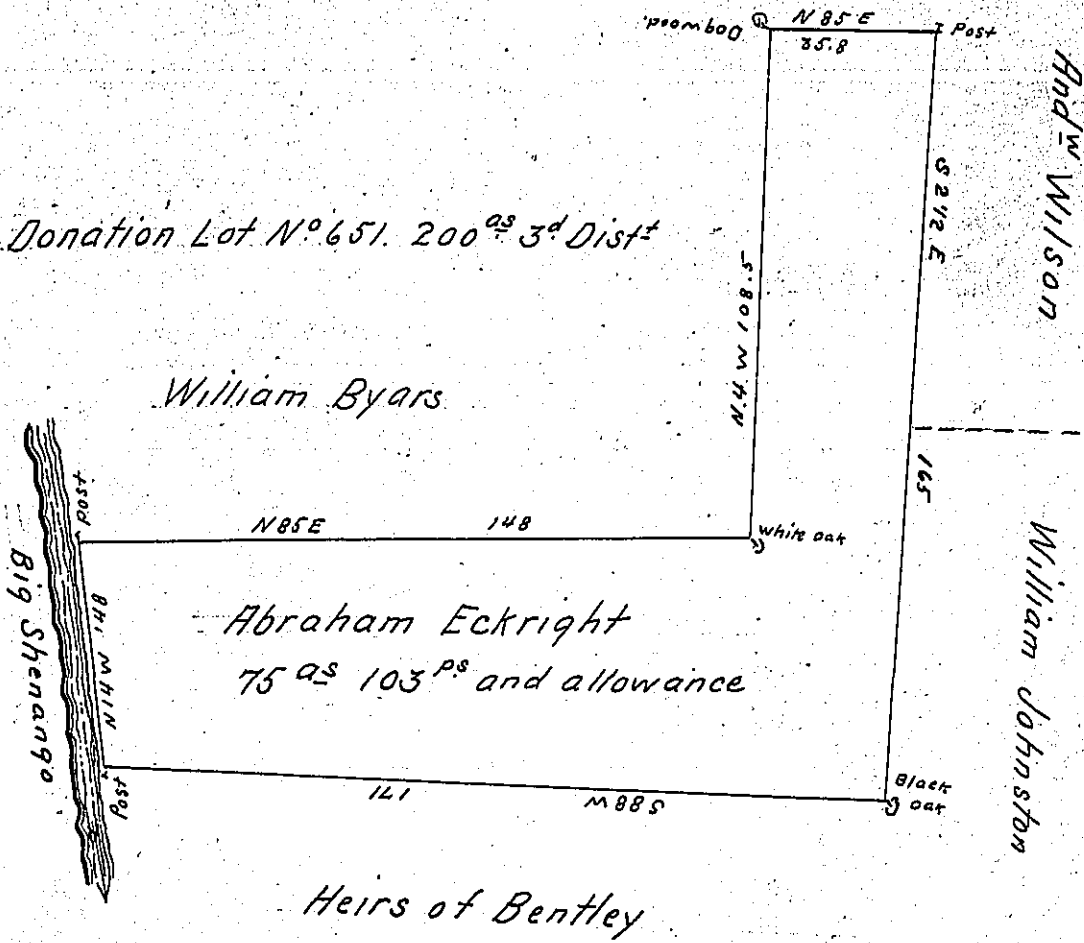

Joining William Byars on Donation lot N^o 651 in the 3^d Dist^t of Donation on the north And^w Wilson & William Johnston on the East the heirs of Bentley on the South and Shenango on the West &c. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Abraham Eckright bearing date the 12th day of April 1825. Executed the 14th day of December A.D. 1825. And I further Certify that from the Books and other documents in my office ~~that~~ it does not appear that this land has been appropriated to any person other than Abraham Eckright or those under whom he claims Given under my hand this 26th day of December 1825.
