



Situate on the west side of French—in Allegheny County containing 401 acres 150 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Resurveyed the 12th July 1799 In pursuance of a warrant of 400 acres granted to Arch^d Engle. Bearing date the 30th May 1792. It being the same tract of land which was Surveyed the 6th November 1794 for Isaac Dunn on his improvement dated 5th Nov. 1794.
