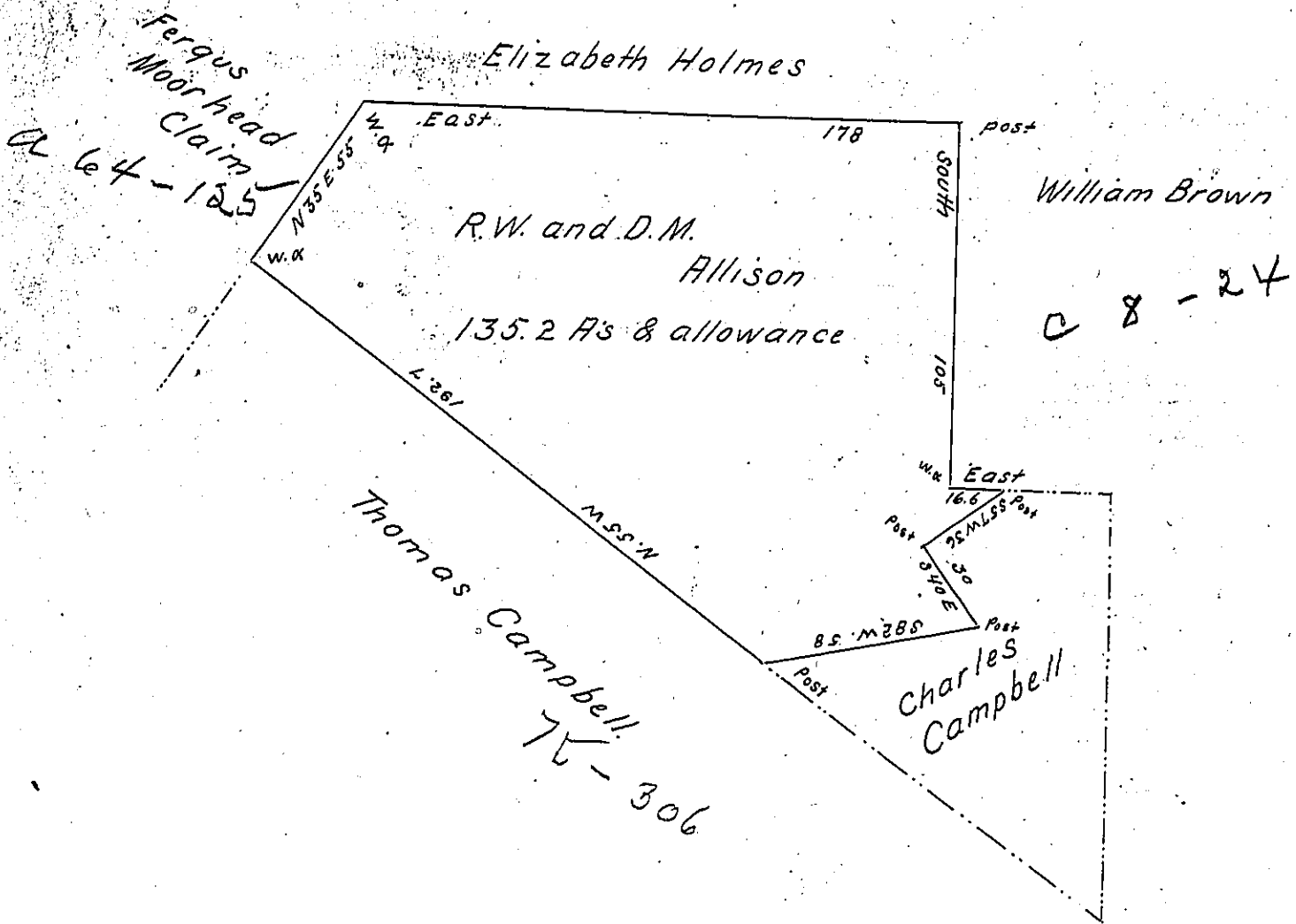

A Draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of White and County of Indiana, containing one hundred thirty five acres thirty two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads, etc. Surveyed for R.W. and D.M. Allison on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 1900, it being part of a larger tract containing one hundred and ninety acres forty perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Chas. Campbell dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of June 1773.
