



By virtue of a warrant dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of May 1792 and order of survey rec<sup>d</sup> the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1851, surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> of April 1851 to James Duncan for Jonathan Taft the above described Tract of land Situate in Palmyra Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining land surveyed to the Hon. Proprietors on Wallin-Paupack Creek, Containing Four hundred and Nineteen acres one hundred and forty perches and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
