



Situate on Milk & Water creek, in Monroe (formerly Providence) township Bedford County containing 225 acres 43 perches & allowance of 6 per. Cent for roads &c. Originally surveyed by Matthew Taylor, the 18th of April 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Joseph Dunken for 200 acres, dated the 27th of June 1789; And resurveyed by Lewis Hoons the 1st of Aug^t 1842.
