



A Draught of a tract of land called — situate on the waters of Tunkhannock Creek, in the County of Luzerne adjoining Peter Fritz & others, surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> day of Novem<sup>r</sup> 1792 for Frederick Fritz, in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July 1792, Containing Four hundred twenty seven acres & thirty two perches & the usual allowance of Six Per Cent for roads &c.
