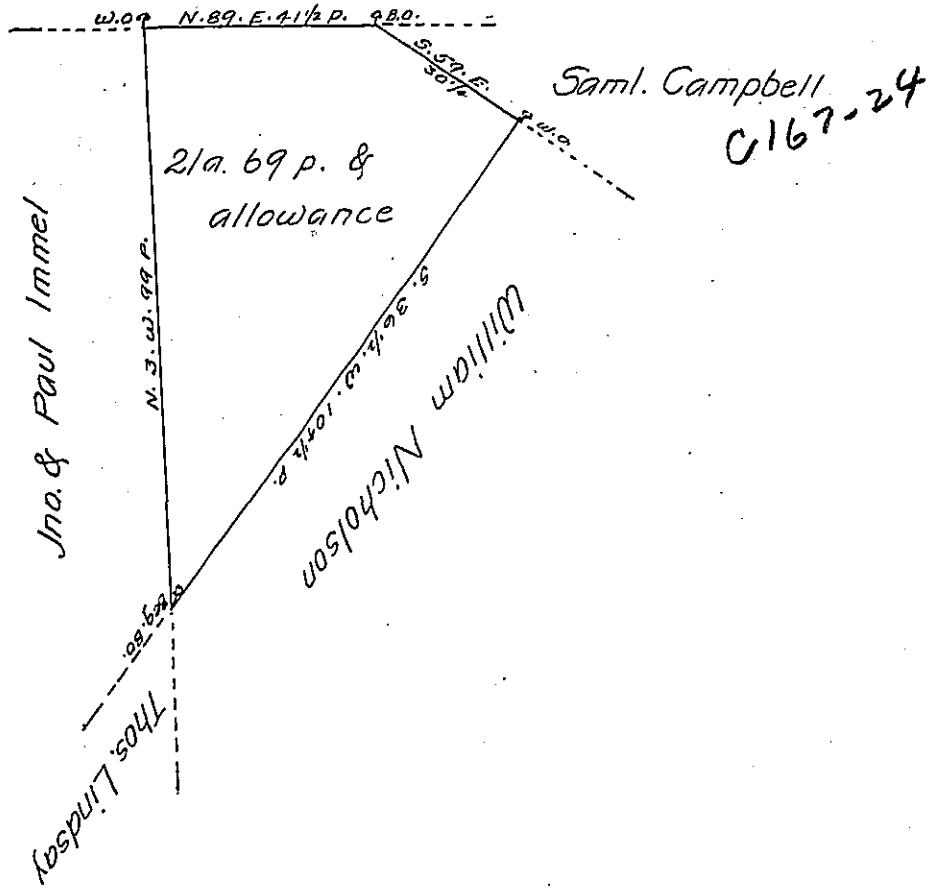

A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Green Township in the  
 formerly in the County of Cumberland  
 County of Franklin, Containing twenty one acres and sixty nine Perches  
 and an Allowance proportional to Six p. Cent. for Roads &c. Survey'd August  
 29th. 1772 (under the Direction of John Armstrong Esqr. then Deputy Surveyor)  
 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Culbertson bearing Date the 10th.  
 Day of February 1763.
