We the Commissioners for adjusting Clames to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahalea Yohoganea and Ohio do hereby Certify that Hugh Gilleland is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Ohio on Buffeloe Creek to include his Actual Settlement made in the Year one thousand Seven hundred and Seventy two also a right in Preemption to one hundred and fifty Acres Adjoining thereto.

Given under our hands at Cox's fort the twenty Second day of February 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
