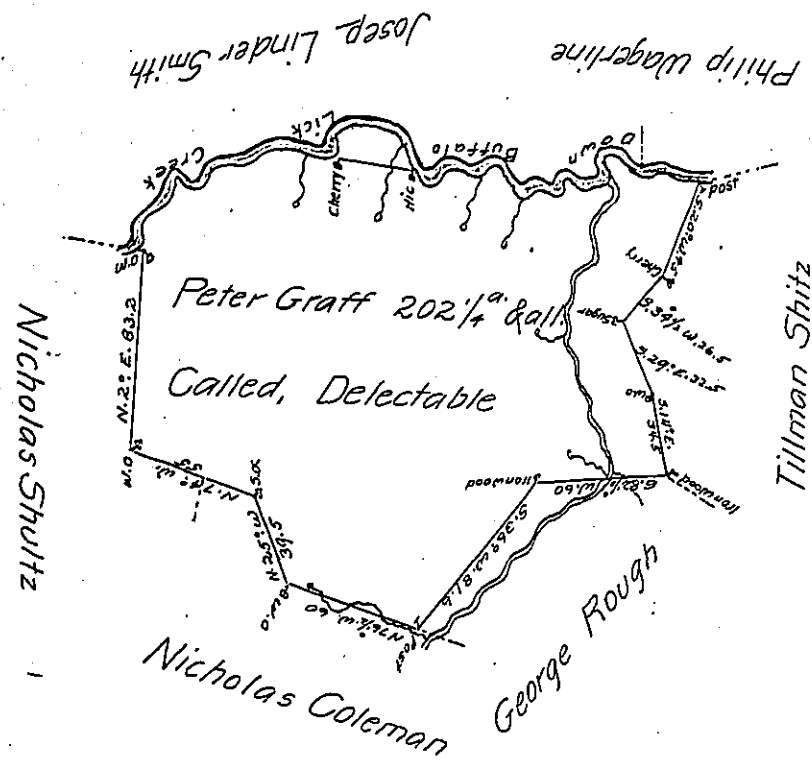


Courses and Distances up Buffalo Lick Creek from the Bank are as followeth
