



A Draught of a piece of Land Situate in Springfield Township (formerly Shrewsbury) in the county of York Containing as above set forth 177 acres and allowance which is part of 176^{ac} 146^{prs} and allowance which was Originally Surveyed on the 8th day of the 12th Mo 1773 in pursuance of two warrants one for 100^{ac} and the other for 50^{ac} both dated the 31st May 1763, and said to be resurveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant directing to resurvey dated the 13th day of September 1773 &c. And now on the 5th day of November A.D. 1839 Resurveyed the above according to the old lines at the request of John Ludwig the present Owner who wishes the same to be returned for Patenting &c.
