Note, This Land was Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> of June 1787, by George Woods Dep<sup>y</sup> Survr Vizt 113<sup>a</sup> 156 pr, the surplus is now discovered to interfere with a Survey made formerly for George Bertsh and since Patented.
