



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 11<sup>th</sup> March 1794  
 Surveyed the 12-June 1797 to Jacob Davis the above discribed tract  
 of Land Situate on the branch of Mahoning creek in West Penn  
 Township Schuylkill County Containing one hundred and eighty  
 five Acres and the allowance of Six per Cent for roads, &c.  
 Resurveyed at the request of Daniel Gerver this 7<sup>th</sup> of April 1845
