



Situate in Codorus Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 121¹/₂ & 25 Perches and allowance of 6 Per Cent & being part of a large Tract of Land Originally surveyed by William Mathews late D.S. on the 12th of the 11th Month 1766, for Ulrich Fullowiaer, In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100⁰ dated the 1st day of June Anno Domini 1762, Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 18th day of March AD. 1794. And now at the request of the Present Owner Zachariah Shoe I am Desired to make return of the draught as Calculated examined & Corrected the 16th day of June AD. 1809.
