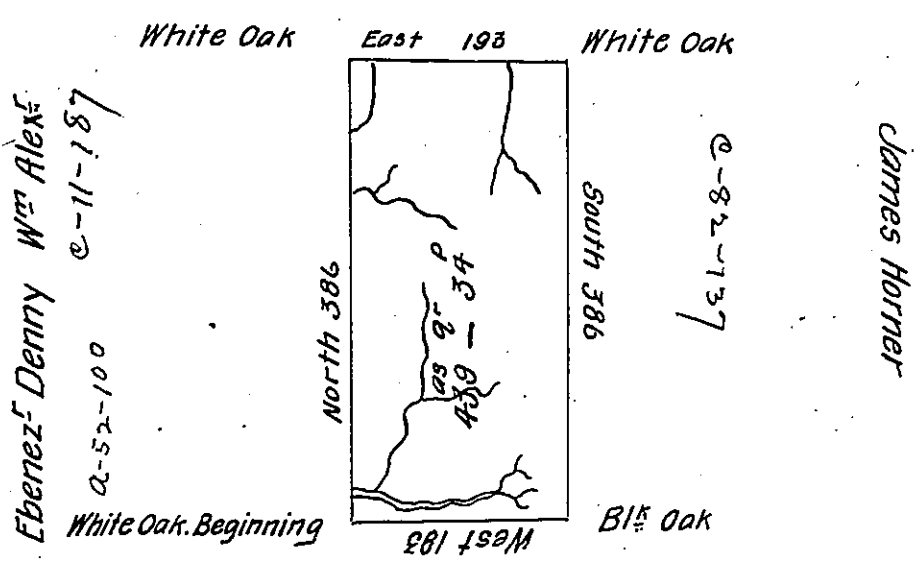

The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 23^d Day 1794 in pursuanc of a Warrant granted to Matthew Ernest for 400 acres of land Dated February the 10th 1794 Situate adjoining Ebenezer Denny and on the North Side of the Large Stream that Empties into Big Beaver North and West of the River Ohio in Destrict No 9 on the Waters of Brush Creek Containing four hundred thirty nine acres and thirty four poles together with the usual allowance of six pr Cent for Roads. Called Walnut flat
