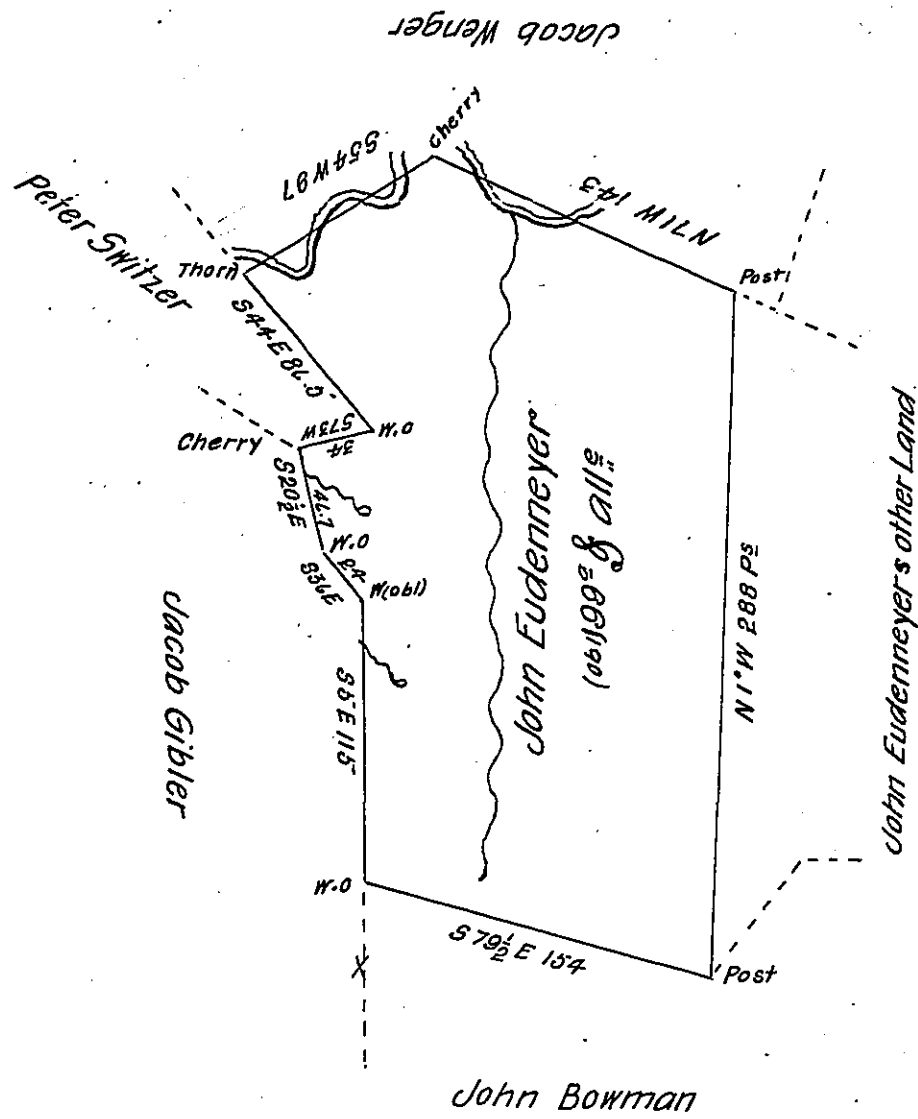

In pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Eudenneyer for 300^{ac} dated the 20th day of October 1788. Certified the 6th day of June 1804.
