



A draught of a Tract of Land called Clover Meadow. Situate on ~~the~~ north side of Tussey's Mountain in Friends Cove on both sides of the Cove Creek adjoining and below Land of George Woods Esq<sup>r</sup> called the Flat Spring and Lands of John Fraser Esq<sup>r</sup> or ~~or~~ Buchannon and adjoining and above Land of Samuel Wallis in Colerain Township in the County of Bedford Containing fifty one Acres and the usual Allowance of six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1772 for Richard Evans in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June 1762 by
