the Susquehanna about $3\frac{1}{4}$ Miles above the Cherry Tree. Containing three
hundred forty two acres one hundred & forty six perches & the usual allow-
ance of 6 P Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 8th day of August 1838 in
pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Fell dated the 18th Day of Dec-
ember 1793 for 400 acres
