
Claim of William Noble



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Tyrone Township in the County of

Cumberland Containing two hundred and Sixty six Acres and 105 Perches

and an Allowance of Six Acres P Cent for Roads Resurvey'd the 19th Day

of December 1768 for Thomas Elliot in pursuance of the Honourable the Proprietary's Warrant bearing Date the 6th Day of February 1755.

The above is resurveyd agreeable to the Mark'd Lines of an Original Survey made of the same, except the Line [N 79\$ E], which takes in the Triangle A included between that & the Prick'd Lines formerly mark'd, containing about 15\$ as, disputed by William Noble, but which is presumed to have been included in a Draught of the same intended to have been Return'd, but unfortunatly was burnt.
