



In Pursuance of a Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Jacob Teterick on a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumb^d marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and Eighty five. Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Elderberry Street Sixty feet and Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Elderberry Street aforesaid. Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred and Eighty Eight. Northward by Billberry Alley, and Westward by River Alley. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 23^d day of August 1774 for Valentine Geiger by Warrant dated the 20th day of August 1774.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of November 1904
