



I do hereby Certify that in pursuance of an Order from the Secretary the above Lot of Ground was laid out and Surveyed for Jacob Grotz Senior the same Situate in Easton in the County of Northampton On the East side of Pomfret Street bounded on the West by said Street on the North by Lot N^o 60. on the East by a twenty feet Alley and on the South by Lot N^o 64. Containing in breadth 60 feet and in Depth 240 feet and marked in the General Map of the said Town N^o 62. And that the said Jacob Grotz Senior has built thereon a frame House filled up with stone twenty eight foot in front and in depth twenty four feet Given under my Hand this 12th day of April Anno 1771.
