



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the Tenth Day of May Anno Dom. 1738 The Above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> of November 1739 Unto John Graham in the Township of Hanover in the County of Lancaster &c. Beginning at a Beech Standing by a Run Called Bow Creek Thence North 53° East 230 perches to a Post &c. Containing Two Hundred and Twenty two Acres Beside the Allowance of Six p. Cent.
