Originally surveyed to Matthias Egner by warrant dated the 8-May 1750 \* Resurveyed and the last mentioned tract divided the 20-August 1784 at the request of Peter Dankle and Jacob Dankle Peter Dankle-part containing forty nine acres fifteen perches & allowance of six P. Cent.
