



Situate in Warrington Township, York County, and containing as above set forth 128^{as} 80^{ps} and allowance. Being a part of a larger tract which was originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 11th day of August 1755 in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 24th day ~~of~~ of June 1755 granted to Caleb Edmundson. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 11th day of November 1788 by John Forsyth late D.S. and now, after having been carefully examined, corrected & calculated from the official draughts, it is at the request of the present owner, Conrad Hobach, returned for confirmation, the 31st day of May Anno Domini 1810.
