In pursuance of a warrant granted to Philip Ehmiq bearing date the 27th day of January 1757. The above resurveyed and laid off from the said larger tract of land by Thomas Armor late D.S. under George Stevenson late D.S. on the 9th day of October A.D. 1767. And now at the request of the present owner George Ehmiq son of the said (Philip Ehmiq) we are desired to make return of the draught as calculated and examined the 27th day of November A.D. 1806
