



Situate in Chanceford Township York County, and containing as above set forth 56 as 84 ps & allowance of land. Being a part of a larger tract of 182 as 126 ps & allowance, which was originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 13th day of the 11th mo. 1772 for Francis Grove, in pursuance of a warrant for 150 as dated the 19th day of August 1772. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 20th of the 5th mo. 1794. And now at the request of the present owner Jacob Grove returned for confirmation the 5th day of January A.D. 1811.
