Surveyed unto oblit Erwin the ~~the~~ above described Island situate in the River Delaware called "Wall's Island" opposite lands of W^m and Martin Marshall and opposite Marshalls Island in Tinicum Township Bucks County containing twenty three acres and sixty eight perches and the usual allowance of six per cent, this 27th day of December 1810.
