Surveyed the 16th day of July A.D. 1806 for Leonard Conrad in right of George Stober & E (It being part of a larger tract of 108 1/2 ^{ac} of land) besides the allowance of six P cent for roads &c. Surveyed unto George Stober (in right of William Ernest) by virtue of a warrant dated the 3^d day of November A.D. 1736.
