



A draught of a tract of land surveyed December 14<sup>th</sup> 1813 in pursu-  
 ance of a warrant granted to Ephriam Elston for 125 acres dated Febru-  
 ary 5<sup>th</sup> 1813 situate in Amwell township called the still cap containing one  
 hundred and thirty one acres and one hundred and fifteen perches and  
 allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
