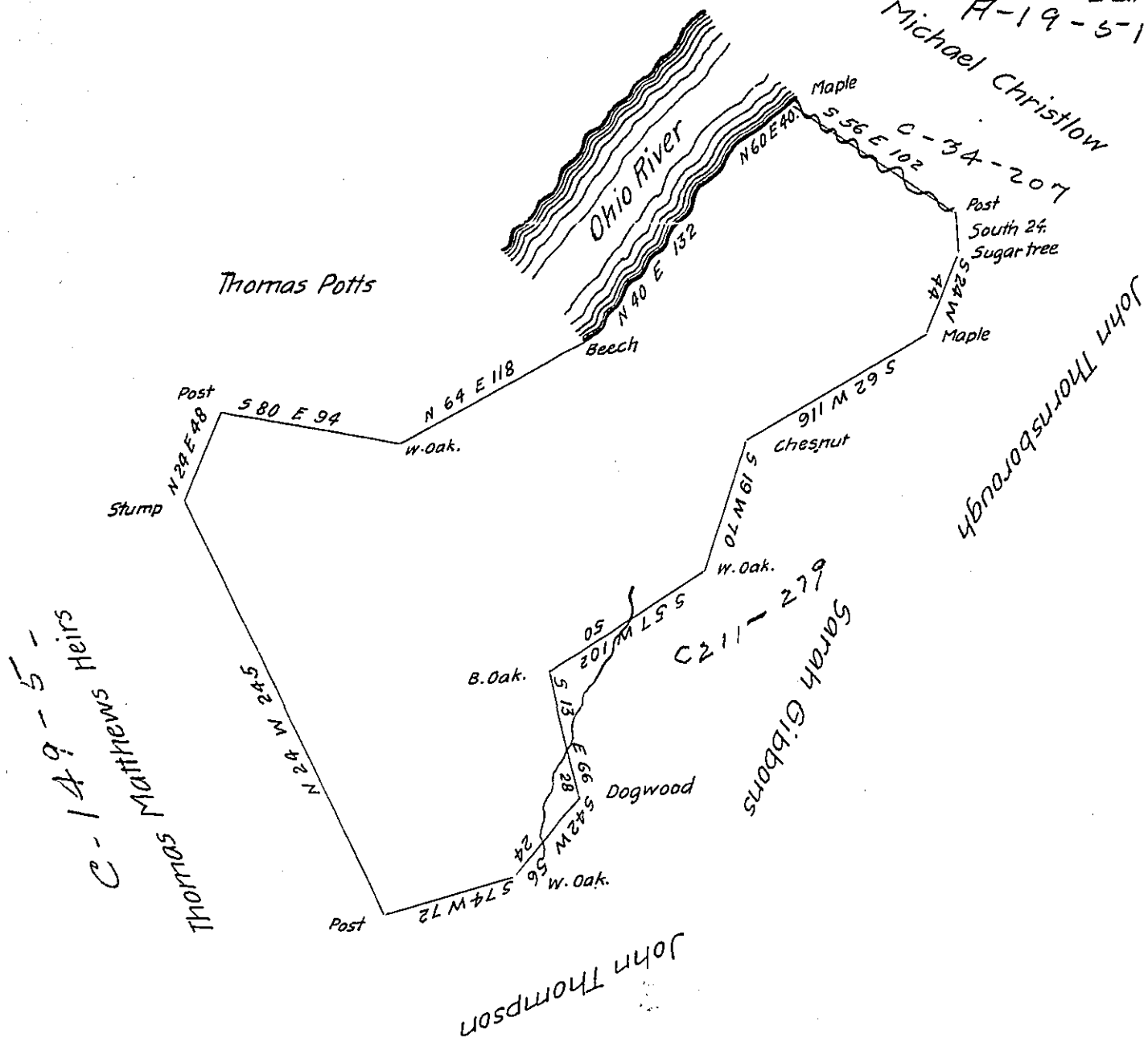


Greene BEAVER 211

The above is a draught of a survey executed the 21st day of Sept:  
 1814 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Eaton, Johnston Eaton and  
 Margaret Eaton dated the 11th day of March 1785 Situate on the south side  
 of the Ohio River formerly in Washington County, now in Green-Township  
 Beaver County containing 421 acres & 128 perches and allowance of six  
 per cent
