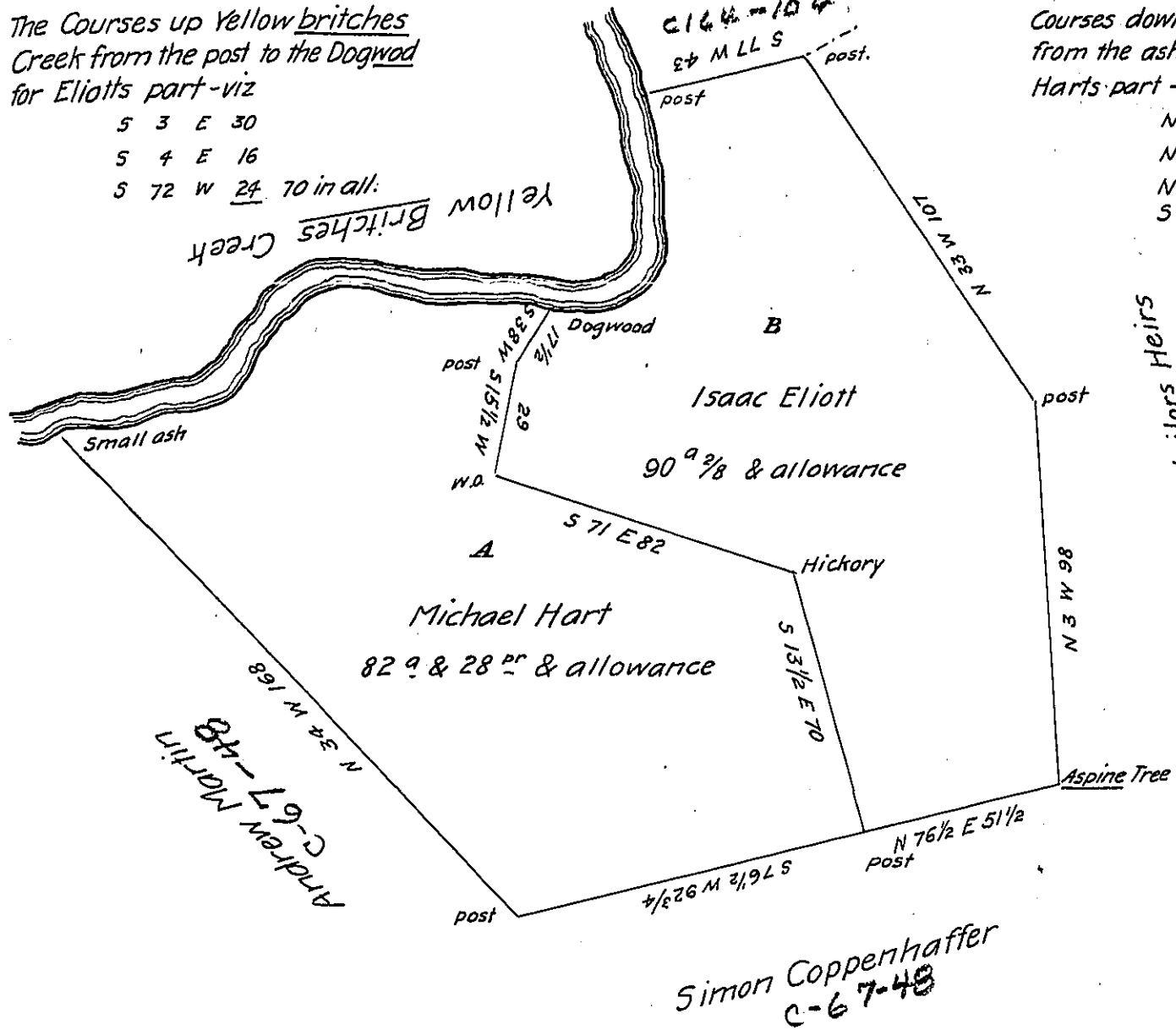


The Courses up Yellow Britches Creek from the post to the Dogwood for Elliotts part - viz
