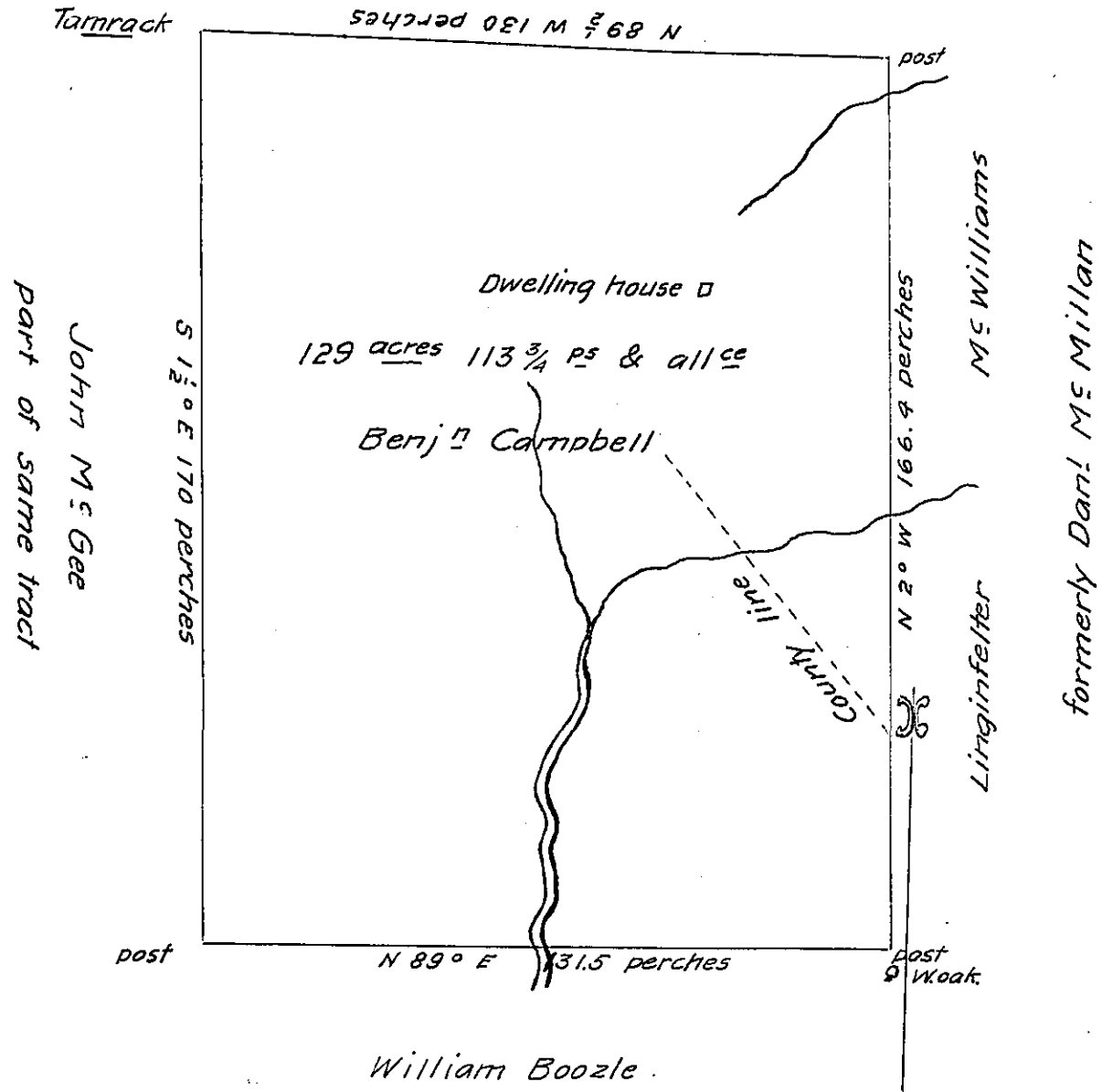

Campbell of a tract of land on the waters of Slipperyrock — partly in Wolfcreek township Mercer county and partly in Slipperyrock township Lawrence county (the dwelling house in Mercer county) bounded and containing as marked in the above plot to wit one hundred and twenty nine acres one hundred & thirteen & $\frac{3}{4}$ perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed January 22nd 1851 being part of a tract settled by Samuel Campbell.
