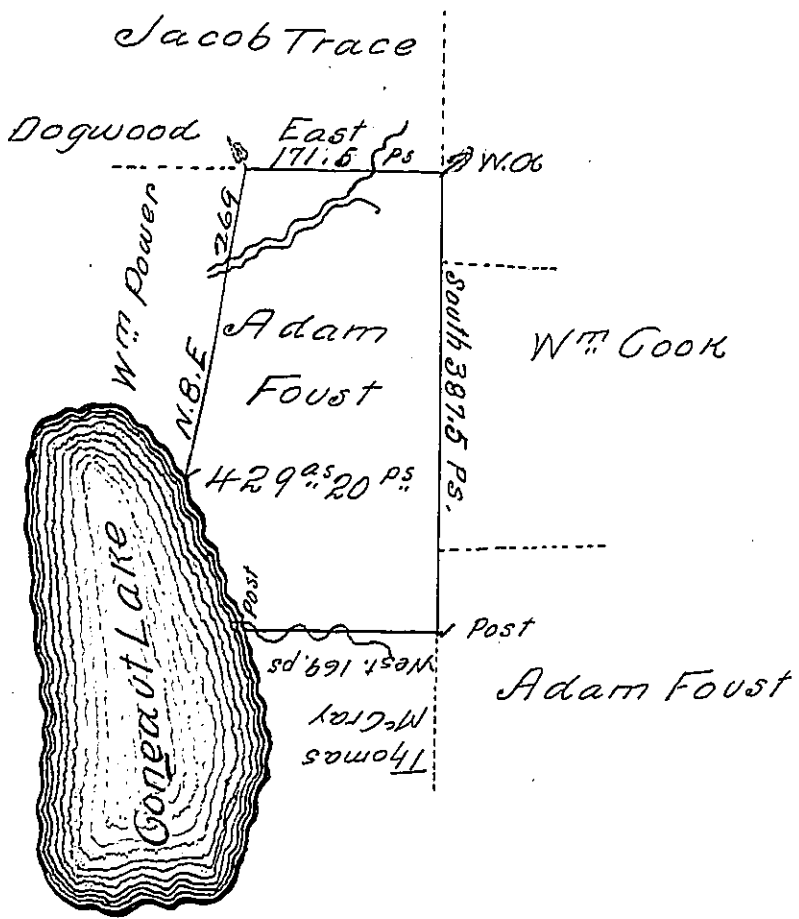

In pursuance of a Warrant for 400<sup>ac.</sup> of Land Dated the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1813 Was surveyed on the 31<sup>th</sup> day of August 1813 for Adam Foust the above discribed tract of Land containing Four Hundred Twenty nine acres and twenty perches and a allowance of Six pr Cent for Roads &c Situate in Sadsbury Township Crawford County and at the time of making the above survey the said Adam Foust had his son in law Jacob Trace actually living on the same with his family under him- and that there appeared to be Cleared, fenced and Cultivated more than twenty acres of the Land and had a house fit for the habitation of man- and the other buildings thereon
