



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Lack Township  
 (formerly Cumberland) now Mifflin County appears  
 survey'd the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 1768 (by William  
 MacLay late Deputy Surveyor) and said to contain  
 Two hundred and seventeen acres and nine tenths  
 of an acre & the allowance of six p<sup>er</sup> Cent for Roads  
 &c. In pursuance of an order of Survey To Robert  
 M<sup>rs</sup>Guillan Bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 11<sup>th</sup> day of  
 May 1767 N<sup>o</sup> 3668 - Examined the 28<sup>th</sup> day of  
 January 1803 and appears Correct
