



Situate in Dover Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 126<sup>45</sup> of 100 perches and allowance. Originally surveyed by George Smith D.S. under Thomas Cookson late D.S. on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1744. In pursuance of a warrant for 50<sup>as</sup> granted Lawrence Greer dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of February 1742. Resurveyed by the old lines the 30<sup>th</sup> November AD 1812 at the request of the present owners Andrew Hantz and John Knisely who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation
