



July 7th 1813. Survey'd the above described part of a tract of land Containing ninety nine acres and one hundred & forty six perches of allowance proportioned at six per cent. It being part of a larger tract said to contain two hundred & ninety four acres of allowance of six per cent which was surveyed to Mary Parker on the 31st day of October 1781 on order No. 2568 situate near Conemaugh river & west of the Kittanning path in Derry Township in the County of Westmoreland.
