A Draught of a tract of land— Situate in Washington Township (formerly Northumberland now) Lycoming County surveyed on the twentieth day of December 1809, by Thomas Wooside the then deputy Surveyor of Northumberland County for Frederick Fulmer by virtue of his warrant dated the 13th day of June 1796, Containing three hundred and nine Acres and one hundred & thirty five perches with the allowance of six per cent.

Note the improvements is a house with a family residing therein and about four or five acres cleared Land, returned by me.
