



In pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the twenty first day of April 1794 granted to Philip Fisher was surveyed on the ~~first~~ Eighth day of July, A.D. 1817 the above Discribed tract of Land Containing 409 acres 175 ps. and allowance of six per Cent, for Roads, &c. situate in Fallowfield Township Crawford County, and at the time of making the same John Cook was residing thereon and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appered to be upwards of thirty acres of the Land Cleared, fenced and in a state of Cultivation, and that the same was Divided as above stated between Joseph Clark & the said John Cook
