



Surveyed the above described tract of land on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August 1827 by the request of Andrew Flatt Jun. in pursuance of a warrant granted to his father in the name of Andrew Flatt dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1792 agreeable to the old lines made by W<sup>m</sup>. Ellis Esqr in the year 1793 then Northumberland now Lycoming County Muncy Township containing two hundred and ninety five acres eighty six perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c.
