Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of August 1820, in pursuance of a Warrant for 7<sup>9</sup>s granted to Samuel Gross, bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1819.

The Improvements on the above described Land at the time of the Surveying thereof consisted of entire cleared Land, composed of part of Sundry adjacent fields but no buildings
