Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Dickey for fifty acres of land Dated the 6th day of May A D 1817 - June 13th 1817 being the day on which the survey was executed

The above tract of land is claimed by the Administrator of one Andrew Vent, who made an Improvement thereon in the year 1784 by building a house & clearing land &c. and has continued to make it his place of abode ever since until his Death which was in the year 1815 this statement was proven by the oath of Isaac Miller and others in my presence W^m V Leet

The above mentioned William Leet is the person that I deputised to execute the above survey I therefor consider myself responsible for the truth of every fact he has stated respecting the same.
