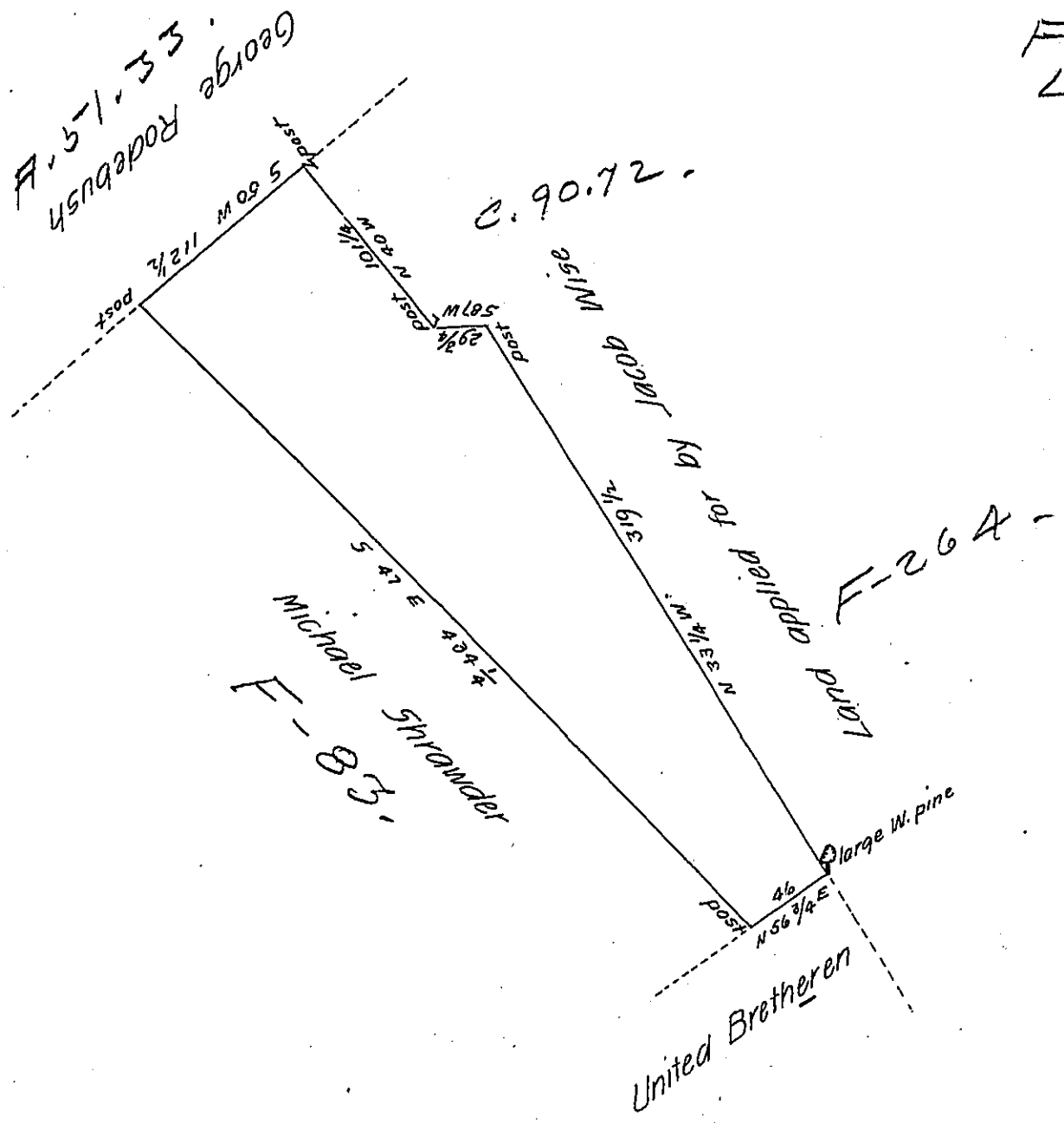


Foster-Luzerne

 the allowance of Six p Cent &c<sup>a</sup>
