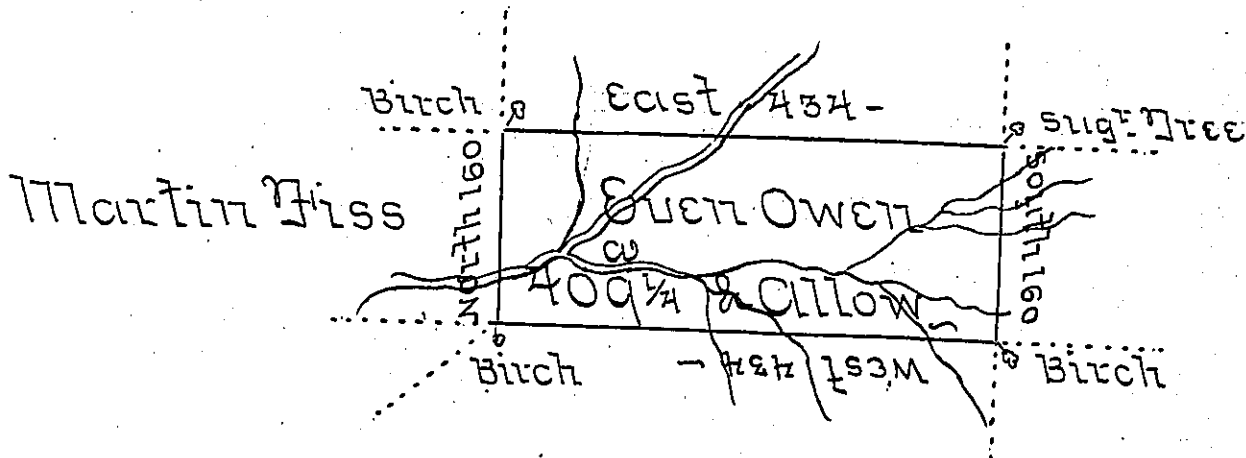

A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on the Waters of Loyalsock Creek Adjoining Land of Ellis Hughes & Others in Loyalsock Township in the County of Northumberland, Surveyd on the Second day of November 1788 in Pursuance of Warrant Granted to Evan Owen Dated the first day of July 1784 Containing Four Hundred & Nine Acres & one Quarter, & the Allowance of six Percent for Roads &c. This Warrant was Remov'd from the Waters of Catawassa Creek, the land being Appropriated as Appears by a Certificate under the Hand of the Deputy Surveyor of that District &c.
