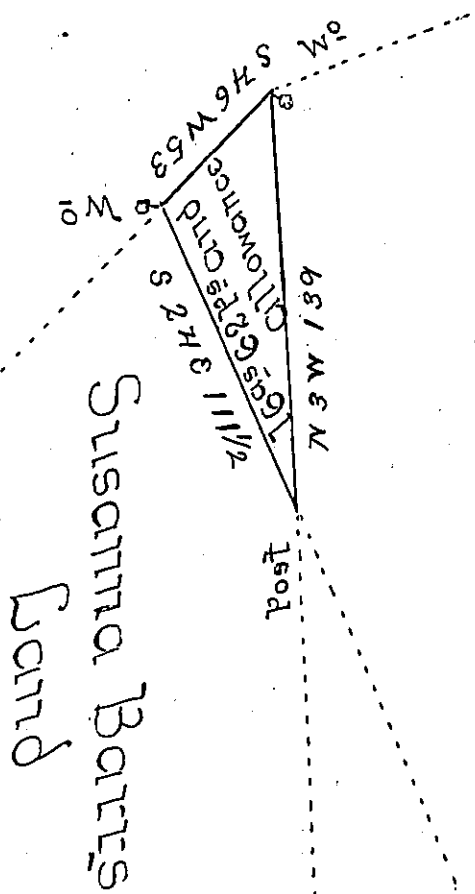


James Ellisons Land
