Situate in Newbury Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 106 2/3 & 26 perches and allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 166 2/3 & 84 perches &c. which was originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. in Pursuance of the Application No. 3087 for 200 2/3 Granted to William Willson bearing date the 17th day of March A.D. 1767. Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 13th day of December A.D. 1814 for and at the request of the present owner Alexander Fraizer who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation
