



Draft of a tract of land situate in the Township of Albany County of Bradford including an improvement and containing two hundred acres and an allowance of six per cent surveyed to Michael Flannery Sept. 28<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1849 in pursuance of a Warrant dated 15<sup>th</sup> July 1842

That part of the above draft which lies North of the Gunning Bedford & East of the Peter Bedford containing one hundred and sixty-nine acres & allowance, was surveyed by the Deputy Surveyor in 1842 and a copy kept but as no return ever reached the land office, I was desired to make a Resurvey and take in of the Peter Bedford & Bethia Young to make the 200 acres applied for which I have done. I found no old marks on the ground to correspond with either of the Bedford surveys or with the Bethia Young nor is there any record of such surveys in my office. I am of the opinion that those three Warrants if they ever have been laid at all lie farther South and that there is a triangular tract of some 4 or 500 acres known as the Sirenah Swift tract of which the above is a part
