



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the first day of February 1785 Originally surveyed to John Fry for one hundred and Eight acres and one hundred and one hundred and fifty seven Perches and the allowance of 6 p. Ct & c. the above described tract of land situate in Heidelberg township Northampton County, now Lehigh Resurveyed December the 6<sup>th</sup> 1839, according to the Courses and distances as the same has been held by the Present owner and his Predecessors for many years past. Containing one hundred and six acres and one hundred and twenty Nine Perches and the allowance of six per Ct & c. and returned for Jonathan Shmek.
