



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 9th day of October Anno. 1752. granted to Jacob Frack. The above described Two Tracts of Land situated in Lowhill Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania adjoining on the East and West side of the other Land of the said Jacob Frack. (But the said Jacob Frack having sold his First Tract of Land, Part of it to Nicholas Manebach and the other Part to Peter Strein.)

The first of the above Tracts contains Twenty two Acres 27 Perches and the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads and the other Tract contains Thirty six Acres and sixty Perches and the said Usual Allowance. Together Fifty eight Acres and 87 Perches with the said Usual Allowance. Were surveyed for the said Peter Strein on the Seventh Day of March Anno. 1758.
