John Torrey being duly affirmed according to law deposeth and saith that the within draught and return of survey is a true copy of an original return in the hand writing of George Palmer, which he, the said John Torrey while holding the Commission of Deputy surveyor for the Counties of Pike and Wayne, sent to the Surveyor Generals office together with seventeen other similar returns for adjacent tracts of land in a sealed envelope, on the fourteenth day of February 1837, with an endorsement on each of said eighteen returns as follows. — "The within survey examined and approved February 14th 1837 John Torrey D.S." And that he is informed that the return of which the within is a copy cannot now be found in the Surveyor Generals office.
