



In pursuance of a Warrant dated 25th of June 1773, the above described Tract of land was surveyed to Georgequest on the 27th of July 1786, by Jos. J. Wallis late Deputy Surveyor, situated on the South side of Tawardane Creek in the County of Luzerne, Containing Three hundred and eighteen acres forty perches, and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c, Certified this 14th day of March 1809.
